

Site Survey

The ultimate goal of an L&M Sturdy Garages site survey is to supply enough information to determine the viability of placing a concrete garage on the site and eliminating any problems. The need and complexity of an L&M site survey will vary depending on the site. Areas looked at are Planning, suitable access and location of the base. An L&M site survey also detects the presence of interference from other sources i.e. neighbours trees and boundaries.

Stages of the site survey:

1. **Inspect access point.** How accessible is the site for construction of the concrete building, i.e. Lorry Access
2. **Inspect the site.** Visual inspection of the proposed site and Suitability for a concrete base is determined. Identifying any potential problems that may effect the erection of a concrete building.
3. **Identify customer's requirements.** Identify the customer's requirements for a Concrete Garage, Workshop or Shed and discuss their options.
